

Please bring...

Bible, pen and notebook.
Money for concession and souvenirs
Pillow
Sleeping bag or bedding for a twin size bed.
Shower towels and washcloths
Shampoo/conditioner and soap
(travel size works best.)
Toothbrush and toothpaste
Enough Pajamas for three nights
3-4 pairs of underwear
3-4 pairs of socks
1 old t-shirt that will get dirty/ruined
1 pair of shorts that will get dirty/ruined
3 nice outfits for evening services
3 days worth of clothing for activities
3 pair of shoes: one to get wet, one for showers,
and one for services.

Dress Code

Knee length shorts may be worn in the morning and afternoon for both boys and girls. (shorts shorter than the knee are not allowed)
ALL clothing must cover shoulders, backs, sides and midriffs at all times.
Apparel may NOT display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language.
No tight fitting clothes of any kind.
Shoes must be worn at ALL times.

Camp Policies

The following are guidelines for the entire camp for the protection of each person.

Dorm Rooms and Facilities

Girls and boys are not allowed in the dorms of the opposite sex.
NO food or drinks will be allowed in the dorms.
NO food or drinks will be allowed in the chapel area.
All rooms are to be left clean before classes each day.

Behavior

You are expected to observe habits of personal courtesy and Christian conduct in order to preserve a wholesome atmosphere.
The daily schedule must be followed and attendance at all activities is required.
Stay in lighted areas of the camp at ALL times.
NO ONE is to leave camp without the knowledge of the Camp Director.
Willful destruction of camp and personal property will not be tolerated.

Personal Belongings

ALL MEDICATIONS (prescribed or over the counter) must be in the original container and turned into Sarah Bridges (RN) upon arrival.
ALL MONEY must be turned into Camp office upon arrival.
Respect property rights of others. Do not borrow without permission. The camp is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.
No water guns, balloons, etc. will be allowed inside.
No electronic devices of any kind are allowed at camp. (iPods, MP3 Players, cell phones, CD players, etc.)
Camp leadership reserves the right to search for, hold, and/or dispose of personal items that are not allowed at camp.
